*Mitchell* This Indenture Made this 17 Day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one between Samuel Stephens, Mitchell, and Anna his wife, late Anna Synch daughter and Heiress of Christopher Synch deceased, of the County of Campbell of the one part, James Stepto, and Caleb Tate of the same County and James Callaway Swin of the County of Bedford of the other part. Whereas the said Christopher Synch in his life times was seized and possessed of a certain tract or parcel of Land containing Eight hundred nine and a half acres situate lying and being in the County of Campbell aforesaid on Block Water Creek and being so seized and possessed he the said Christopher died without any Will; by virtue whereof the said tract or parcel of Land descended to the said Anna, as his legal representative, who hath since intermarried with the said <sup>Samuel</sup> Mitchell. NOW this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Samuel and Anna for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty two pounds two shillings to them in hand paid by the said James Stepto Caleb Tate and James Callaway Swin before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said James Stepto, Caleb Tate and James Callaway Swin their Heirs and Assigns forever all their right title and Interest of in and to the said tract or parcel of Land containing Eight hundred nine and half acres and bounded as follows, *Beginning* at a Mulberry on James River W<sup>m</sup> Scotts corner thence south thirty eight and half degrees, West two hundred and eleven poles to
