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RENOVATIONS OF LYNCHBURG AND AMHERST BRIDGE

The collection includes contract and specifications for the renovation of the iron bridge across the James River between Lynchburg (Va.) and Amherst County (Va.)

In 1897, The Lynchburg City Council and the Amherst County Board of Supervisors determined that repairs for the iron bridge crossing the James River between Lynchburg and Amherst County. Specifications of materials and workmanship to be used in the renovations were drawn up by L.P. Rodes, city engineer of the Lynchburg, on 20 March 1897. The contract was awarded to R.H. Coleman, of Lynchburg, on 19 April 1897, by F.B. Tyler, for the Board of Supervisors of Amherst County, and James I. Lee, chairman of the Committee on Streets of the Lynchburg City Council.
