Lurline Bailey was the daughter of Robert Gordon Bailey. She married George Everette Bond, son of Robert Nelson and Annie Elizabeth Bond, in 1937, and they had four children, George Everette, Jr., Nancy, Helen and Anne.

Elizabeth Bond, daughter of Robert Nelson and Annie Elizabeth Bond, was born on February 22, 1886. She married Stanhope Johnson, son of George and Mary Elizabeth Johnson, on October 26, 1921. She died on February 12, 1967. Stanhope Johnson, who was born on February 16, 1881, was a prominent Lynchburg, Virginia architect, as well as a horticulturist and a landscape architect. He died on January 11, 1973.

Nancy Bond Brothers, daughter of Lurline Bailey Bond and George Everette Bond, was born and raised in Lynchburg, Virginia. She graduated from E.C. Glass High School in 1958. She married John A. Brothers, Jr. and settled in New Orleans, Louisiana.
