MERIWETHER ANDERSON SALE, SR. (1942-)

Meriwether Anderson (Andy) Sale, the son of William Goodridge Sale and Ann Meriwether Anderson, was born 3 August 1942 in Charleston, West Virginia. A graduate of Davidson College in North Carolina and Union Theological Seminary in Richmond, Virginia. He married Frances Ferguson Wood of Johnson City, Tennessee, in June 1965. He served in pastorates in Kentucky (1969-1972), Virginia (1972-1983) and Missouri (1983-1996). He served as General Presbyter for the 141 congregations in the Presbytery of the Peaks with offices in Lynchburg, Virginia (1996-2004). He retired as interim pastor for Quaker Memorial Presbyterian Church, Lynchburg, Va., in September 2006. With his wife, he moved to Sunnyside Retirement Community in Harrisonburg, Virginia.
