Page 283 of The Index of The Society of The Colonial Wars, 1903-1906: "ALBRO, MAJ. JOHN, 1617-1712. Corp. in Colonial Militia, 1661-66. Lieut., 1675-'80. Capt., 1680, and Major." Only Addis Albro joined on this service - see page 188.

Page 188: The Reverend Addis Albro of Detroit, joined the Michigan Society as #49 (general society #1667), & as sixth in descent from Major John Albro.

Page 412 of The Index of The Society of The Colonial Wars, 1897-1898: "ALBRO, MAJOR JOHN. Corporal in Colonial Militia, 1675-1680. Captain, 1680, and Major." Only Addis Albro joined on this service - see page 33.
