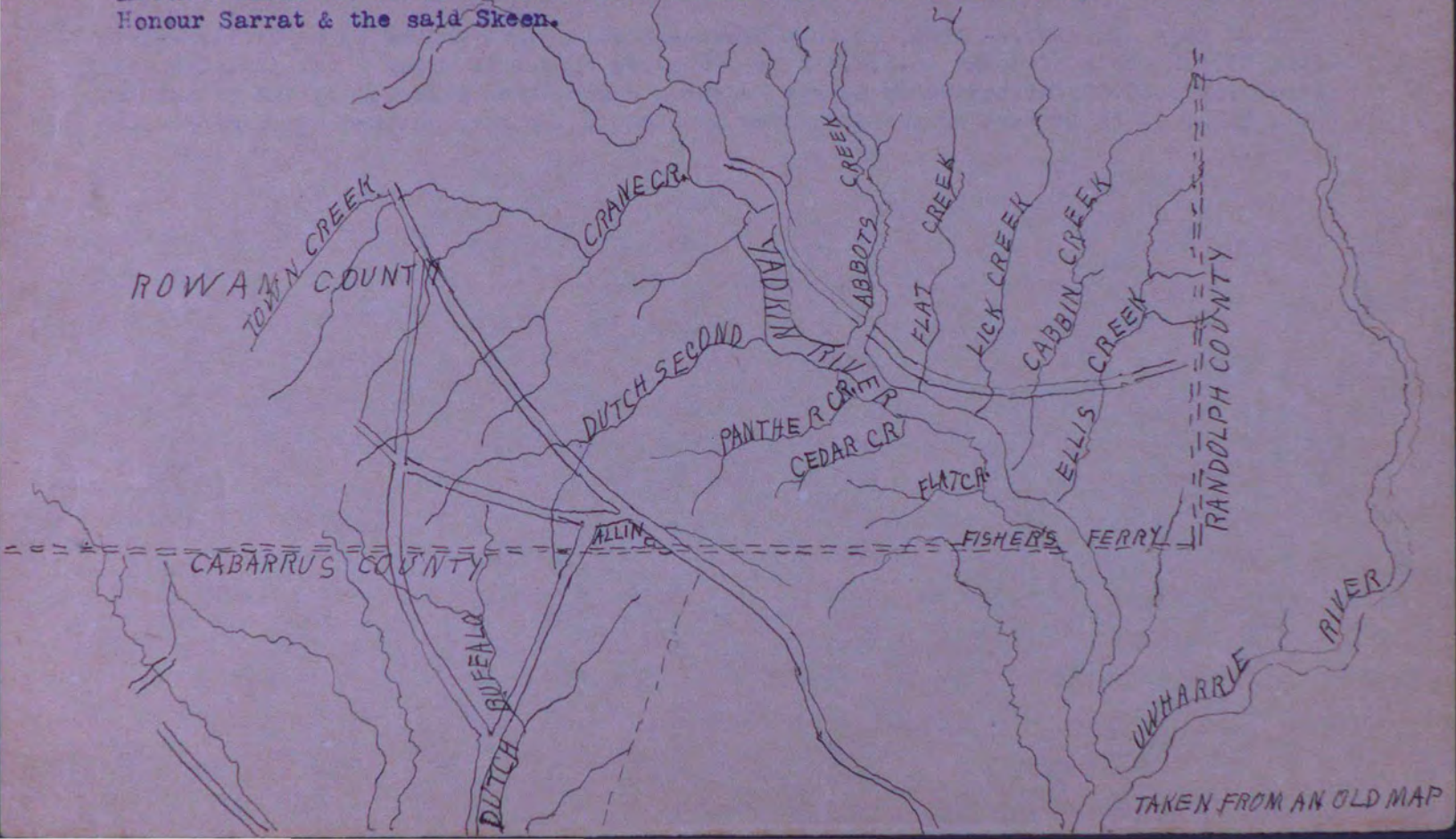

Matthew Skeen (Cabbin Creek)

Book 13 page 731; Nov. 27 1792, The State grants (#2145 at 50 shillings the 100 acres) to Matthew Skeen 200 acres on both sides Cabbin Creek next William Badget, George Russel, Honour Sarrat & the said Skeen.

Matthew Skeen (Cabbin Creek & Randolph County line)

Book 13 page 829: Nov. 27<sup>th</sup> 1792, The State grants (#2127 at 50 shillings the 100 acres) to Matthew Skeen 400 acres on Cabbin Creek on the Randolph line.

Book 23 page 312: Dec.-- 1804, Matthew Skeen--no wife signs but he is a "Citizen"--lets John Wilson (both of Rowan Co.N.C.) have 300 acres on Cabbin Creek & the Randolph County line, for \$450.00, witnessed by George Hearne & James Skeen & proved by the latter in Feb. 1815. (This is part of the 400 acres granted to the said Matthew Skeen on Nov.22 1792).

HARRIS

Matthew Scain (Jacksons Creek)

Book 22 page 626 or 726 (numbered twice); May 24 1800, The State grants (#2689 at ) to Matthew Scain 200 acres on Jacksons Creek on the County line next ---Carron, ---Moore & Jesse Harris.

Book 22 page 446: March 10 1810, Matthew Skeen Sr.--no wife signs--lets Ransom Harris (both of Rowan Co.N.C.) have 200 acres on Jacksons Creek on the County line next---  
---Moore & Jesse Harris, for 100 pounds, witnessed by Matthew Skeen & James Skeen & proved by the latter in Feb. 1812.

Book 19 page 163: Nov. 13 1804, David Ellis & wife Betsey, & Samuel Roberts & wife Hannah, let Matthew Skeen Sr.--all "citizens" of Rowan Co.N.C., have 300 acres on Yadkin River at the mouth of the dividing branch next Nathan Brady & William Coles on north bank, for \$1200.00, witnessed by Jacob Skeen & George Hearne & proved by the latter in Feb. 1805. (This had been granted David Davis on Dec. 8 1802).

Jacob Skeen (South side of Cabbin Creek)

Book 23 page 902: Nov. 19 1816, Jacob Skeen--no wife signs--lets Adam Smith (both of Rowan Co.N.C.) have 60 acres (being part of a tract granted the said Adam Smith) on the south side of Cabbin Creek, for \$250.00, witnessed by Bennet Nooe, George Smith & Abraham Smith & proved by the latter in Nov. 1816.
