Book 23 page 312: Dec.-- 1804, Matthew Skeen--no wife signs but he is a "Citizen"-lets John Wilson (both of Rowan Co.N.C.) have 300 acres on Cabbin Creek & the Randolph County line, for \$450.00, witnessed by George Hearne & James Skeen & proved by the latter in Feb. 1815. (This is part of the 400 acres granted to the said Matthew Skeen on Nov.22 1792).

(This had been granted David Davis on Dec. 8 1802).
