Book 20 page 373: Jan. 14 1814, Mary E. Admire of Rowan Co. N.C. lets Peter Rupard of N.C. have 107 acres on Henlines Creek in the forks of the Yadkin River, for 200 pounds, witnessed by Cornelius Howard & Jesse Walker & proved by the latter in Feb. 1814. (This is part of a State Grant made to said Elizabeth Admire)

Book 9 page 581: Oct. 10 1783, The State grants (#555 at 50 shillings the 100 acres) to Elisabeth Admire 200 acres on Henlines Creek in the fork of the Yadkin River.

The will of Elizabeth Admier (book H page 475) made June 4 1823. Sons: John Rupard & Peter Rupard (5 shillings each).

Daughter: Mary deceased (her daughter Esther Hilton 5 shillings) & her son John Rupard; Elizabeth, Margaret & Rachel.

Exr: grandson John Rupard. Witnesses: Will S. Jones & Ann K. Jones.

Book 27 page 458: --- -- 1821, Elizabeth Admier lets Jacob Cornatzer (both of Rowan Co.) have 50 acres on Elsworths Creek next her tract & John Tomlinson, for \$210.00, witnessed by John Rupard & Williams S. Jones & proven by the latter in Feb. 1823.

Book 9 page 581: Oct. 10 1783, The State grants (#555 at 50 shillings the 100 acres) to Elizabeth Admire 200 acres on Henlines Creek, in the forks of the Yadkin, beginning at a hickory, going north 80 degrees west 54 chains to a pine, south 25 chains to a post oak saplin, east 12 chains to a pine, south 9 chains & 50 links to a pine, east 41 chains & 20 links to an ash, then north to the beginning.

Book 24 page 319: Sept. 12 1817, Peter Rupard--no wife signs--lets John Tomlinson (both of Rowan Co. N.C.) have on Henlines Creek in the forks of the Yadkin River
