Between July & Oct. 1755: "Peter Whisenhunts Mark a Crop off Each Ear & Slit in the Right Ear his Brand thus PW on. " ---

Oct. 15 1763: The Justices & Nassery vs Peter Wisenhunt. Debt. Sur. Sta. Above jury except Samuel Smith & Edwd McGuire instead of David Bire & Jas. Sparks. Not guilty.

Book 5 page 506: Dec. 13 1763, Paul Whissenhunt, a planter of Rowan Co.N.C., --no wife signs--lets Esq. Henry E.McCulloh of Hallifax Co.N.C., have all tract of 230 acres on & crossing a branch, being one of the head waters of Uharee, for 31 pounds, witnessed by Robert Barclay & William Giles & proved by the latter in Jan. 1764.

Jan. 12 1764: Mortgage from Paul Wissonhunt to Henry Eustace McCulloh for 230 acres is proved.

Oct. 4 1763: Deed from Henry McCulloh to Paul Wizenhunt for 230 acres Feb. 24 1763 proved by John Frohock.

Book 5 page 321: Feb.24 (in 3d year of King George III) Esq. Henry McCulloh through his attorney, Henry Eustace McCulloh) lets Paul Wissenhunt of Rowan Co.N.C., have 230 acres in tract #10 on the head waters of Uharie down & crossing a branch, for 17 pounds, witnessed by William Giles, Robert Barclay & Robert Jones Jr. (R.G.) & proved in Oct.1763
