Book 12 page 17: April 27 1790, Thomas Job & wife Hannah let Abraham Little--all of Rowan Co.N.C.--have 100 acres on Ellis Creek next Evan Elliss, Joseph Wolfscale & David Hendrix, for 50 pounds, witnessed by Abraham Hendrix, & Benjamin Kenkle & proved by Benjamin Hendrix(?) in May 1790.

Book 13 page 867: Dec. 8 1790, Abraham Little & wife Margaret let Daniel Orrell--all of Rowan Co.N.C.--have 100 acres on Ellis Creek next Evan Ellis, Joseph Wolfscale & David Hendrix, for 60 pounds, witnessed by Ephriam Adams, William Harper & Rodrick Jinkins & proved by the latter in Feb. 1795.

The will of Edgar Rumley (Book D page 109) made while 'weak in body' on Nov. 9 1792. Wife Ann (the land during widowhood & \$4.00 in hands of Ann Harrington). Sons: Thomas (1/2 of 250 acres over big branch next Isaac Smith which other half goes to my daughter Levice Rumley). Daughters: Levice, Ann Orrel (35 acres next Widow Hendricks, as excepted in the 250 acres) & Lydda Eanochs (\$10.00). Cousin James Rumley (100 acres next James Pelles & rental on James Rumley's land due by Ann Harrington of Carolina County). Exr: Wife & friend Zephaniah Harper. Witnesses: Samson Stephen, Rebecca Smit Book 21 page 24: March 26 1795, Zephaniah Harper & wife Elizabeth let Daniel Orrell (all of Rowan Co.N.C.) have 97 1/2 acres on Carters Creek next the original survey of William McDaniel, & John Johnson, for 75 pounds, witnessed by Enok Enochs, William Harper & Andrew Tucker & proved by the last named in Aug. 1807.

Book 15 page 284: Oct. 20 1797, Daniel Orrell--no wife signs--lets William Branch (both of Rowan Co.N.C.) have 100 acres on Carters Creek next James Pelly, John White, John West & Joseph Bryan, for 60 pounds, witnessed by Zephaniah Harper & John West & proved by the latter in Nov. 1797.

Bryman Peck

Book 21 page 778: April 30 1810, John Peck--no wife signs--lets James Orrell (both of Rowan Co.N.C.) have 100 acres on Carters Creek next James Peck, John Dowell, William Howard & David Sheets, for \$300.00, witnessed by David Sheets & Daniel Orrell & proved by the latter in May 1810.

The will of Nancy Orrell (Book H page 649) made while in a declining state of health on July 15 1833 & prolated in May 1835. Son Samuel (& his heirs) who is Exr. Witnesses: J. Perryman & Samuel Harriss (Jt.)

The will of Daniel Orrell (book H page 502) made Nov. 15 1830. Wife Nancy. Sons: James, Edgar, Robert John, Daniel, William & Samuel. Daughters: Nancy Sheets, Elizabeth Caton, Mary Markland, Leija Etcheson, Anna, & possibly Lethy? Call (whose children are Elizabeth, Gean & Burch Call). Exrs: wife & son Samuel & Gilson Berryman. Attests: J. Ellis & J. Spry.

Book 15 page 376: April 1 1797, Daniel Orrell & wife Nancy let Daniel Caml--all of Rowan Co N.C.--have 100 acres on Ellis Creek next Evan Ellis, ---Wolfscale & David Hendrix, for 100 pounds, witnessed by William Elsberry & John West & proved by the latter in Nov. 1797. Page 378: Another of 35 acres on same day on west side of Linvilles Creek next Michael Hinkle & John Hendrix, for 30 pounds, witnessed & proved as above.

Book 24 page 414: Feb. 20 1817, John Davis Sr. ~~x~~-no wife signs--lets Daniel Orrel of Guilford Co.N.C., have 30 acres on Abbots Creek next Peter Davise & Elizabeth Hitchcock, for \$60.00, witnessed by William Brattain, Ezekiel Teague & Asell Hitchcock & proved by the last named in Feb. 1818. (This is part of the old Davis tract).

Book 19 page 371: Aug. 3 1801, Michael Smith--no wife signs--lets Daniel Orrell (both of Rowan Co.N.C.) have 218 $\frac{3}{4}$ acres on Carters Creek, for \$436.00, witnessed by Jno Warsham & Jacob Smith & proved by the latter in Aug. 1805. (Reversed in index)

Book 31 page 174: Oct. 27 1830, Jonathan Cheshier gives out of love for his children & grandchildren: Sally Jarvis, Nancy Orrell, daughter Eliza both good four children (Phillip, Mary, Isaac & John good), Tineson Cheshier, daughter Ciller Sain's three children (Delpha, Angenetta & Mary Sain), Susanna Jarvis (but \$100.00 to be deducted from her portion), Jonathan Cheshier & Lucy Sain, the proceeds from 449 acres next William Dooling, Benjamin Howard & William Howard, and appoint James Jarvis Sr. & John Orrell to sell the land as soon as possible and divide proceeds, witnessed by John Rupard & J. Berryman & proved by the latter in Feb. 1831.

Pleasant Grove Chapel

Book 22 page 628: Aug. 3 1812, Daniel Orrell lets the trustees of "Pleasant Grove Chappel" M.E. Church, have 1 1/2 acres on Haines Mill Creek next Jos. Locker, for 20 shillings, witnessed by Benjamin Berryman & Jilson Berryman & proved by the latter in Nov. 1812. (These trustees are: Hardy Jones, Charles Caton, Joshua Caton & Daniel Orrell).
