Cyrus Hatcheson (Stumpy Branch)

Nov. 9 1787; "Administration on the Estate of Robert Torrington deceased, Ordered to issue to William and Thomas Erwin, who qualified and Security James Craford in a Bond of 200..0..0"

Feb. 6 1788: An inventory of & account of the sales returned.

Aug.4 1795: "Ordered that Musendine Matthews & William Young Esqrs. of Iredell County settle the Estate of Robert Torrentine with the Administrators & report to this Court". Iredell Co.N.C. book G page 295: Aug.25 1808, Elizabeth Torrentine lets Robert Torrentine (both of Iredell Co.N.C.) have 170 acres next Joseph Byars & Stephen Parker, for 100 pounds, witnessed by George Clayton & George L.Davidson & proved by the latter in May 1810. (Refer to the State Grant of Aug. 9 1787).

Iredell Co.N.C., book K page 21: June 15 1820, Cyrus Hatcheson & wife Elizabeth (Torrentine) let Stephen Parks<sup>d</sup>--all of Iredell Co.N.C.--have 50 acres on Stumpy Branch, for \$200.00, witnessed by George L.Davidson & William S.Kerr & acknowledged on Aug. 22 1820. (This is part of a State Grant to Robert Torrentine on Aug.9 1787).

Nov. 9 1787:" Administration on the Estate of Robert Torrington deceased, Ordered to issue to William and Thomas Erwin, Who qualified and Security James Craford in a Bond of 200..0..0"  
Inventory & account of sales returned on Feb. 6 1788.

Aug. 4 1795:"Ordered that Musendine Matthews, & William Young Esqrs. of Iredell County settle the Estate of Robert Torrentine with the Administrators & report to this Court"

Iredell Co.N.C., book B page 103: Aug.9 1787, The State grants (#1606 at 50 shillings the 100 acres) to Robert Torrentine 342 acres on both sides of Stumpy Run next George Clayton & Galbraith Falls.

Iredell Co.N.C. book K page 21: June 15 1820, Cyrus Hutcheson & wife Elizabeth (Torrentine) let Stephen Parkes or Parker--all of Iredell Co.N.C.--have 50 acres on Stumpy Branch, for \$200.00, witnessed by George L.Davidson & William S.Kerr & acknowledged on Aug. 22 1820. (This is part of a State Grant to Robert Torrentine on Aug. 9 1787).
